3		→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 158 IS CREATED TO
4	REA	AD AS FOLLOWS:
5	<i>(1)</i>	Beginning with the 2023-2024 school year, to graduate from a Kentucky public
6		high school with a regular diploma, a student in his or her final year of high
7		school shall:
8		(a) Complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid form;
9		(b) On a form created by the local district, file a signed noncompletion waiver
10		with the student's high school indicating that the parent or guardian of the
11		student, or the student if he or she is at least eighteen (18) years old or
12		legally emancipated, understands the purpose of the Free Application for
13		Federal Student Aid form and has chosen not to file an application; or
14		(c) Be granted a hardship waiver in accordance with subsection (2) of this
15		section.
16	<u>(2)</u>	If a student is not able to fulfill the requirements of subsection (1)(a) or (b) of this
17		section due to extenuating circumstances set forth in a policy approved by the
18		local board of education, the superintendent may grant a hardship waiver to the
19		student in accordance with the policy.
20	<u>(3)</u>	Each local board of education shall develop policies and procedures to assist
21		students in fulfilling the requirements of this section.
22	<u>(4)</u>	The Kentucky Department of Education shall develop a process for local districts
23		to report student data regarding the completion of the requirements of this
24		section.
